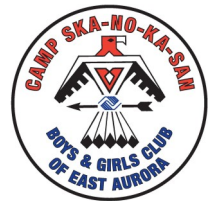




CAMP SKA-NO-KA-SAN 2017



The Boys & Girls Club of East Aurora owns a beautiful **175 acre camp** in the **Town of Holland** that is the site of our summer day camp, Camp Ska-No-Ka-San! This wooded natural setting is the heart of our fantastic outdoor program that includes a 3-acre lake which provides for all types of waterfront activities.

What better way for campers to share their summer days than with other day campers in unique, interesting outdoor activities not to be found in the Village?

WHO CAN GO TO CAMP?
Camp sessions are open to all youth entering grades 2-9 in the Fall of 2017.

WHAT WE DO AT CAMP?
Above all, Camp Ska-No-Ka-San is a place to have **FUN!** Campers enjoy a great day outdoors with a group their own age, and every day is filled with interesting and exciting things to do!

WHO OPERATES THE CAMP?
The camp is staffed by trained, adult professionals from the Boys & Girls Clubs of EA and the Boys & Girls Club of Holland, complemented by select High School students who serve as counselors. The ratio of adult staff to campers is 1:12, affording campers with a rewarding small group experience. Camp staff and counselors are trained in first aid, CPR, and water safety.

HOW DO I GET TO CAMP?
There are two main pick-up/drop-off points
BOYS & GIRLS CLUB EAST AURORA: Busses leave EA Club promptly at 9am each morning, return at 5pm.
NO pick-ups or drop-offs within the Village limits.
BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF HOLLAND: The bus picks up at the Holland Club at about 9:20 am, returns approximately 4:35 pm.
