SAFETY IN THE AGE OF COVID-19

Our goal is to keep everyone - staff, members and families - safe and healthy.

As we begin to re-open, we have broken down our enhanced safety protocols into the following five areas of focus:

1. Health and Wellness of our Members and Staff (Health Screenings)
2. Increased Hand Washing and Sanitizing Protocols
3. Increased Facility Maintenance and Cleaning
4. Best Practices for Social Distancing in the Club Setting
5. Reduction in Group Sizes & interactions with an increase in Staff to Member Ratios

We certainly understand the anxiety and apprehension that you may feel as we begin our “new normal” program environment. We are confident that with these safety revisions, we can safely transition ourselves to provide a quality Club experience for members and staff.

Summer Rec is going to look a lot different this year. We are making numerous changes emphasizing health and safety, while making a host of other changes that are recommended by the CDC, including regular sanitizing, hand-washing, social distancing, reduced hours, cancellation of field trips, and smaller group activities.

Rec registration will be limited to 50 youth per age group to ensure Child/staff safety and social distancing guidelines compliance. We must comply in order to open.

PROGRAM DETAILS



- Participants will be broken up into 10 children “pods” and will be assigned two staff members that will stay with them the entire time.
- The pods will travel between the program areas together as a group and will not interact with other pods.
 - Program Areas will include: Gym, Gamesroom, Craft Room, Outside, Mezzanine & Computer Lab
- Staff members will wear facemasks, kids are not required to.
- Frequent hand washing will be performed throughout the day.
- In-Vehicle temperature checks and health assessments will be done at drop-off.
- Prompt Drop-off and Pick-up are essential. You Must drop-off your child when scheduled and pick them up on time or jeopardize further participation.
- Your child’s pod will be assigned a designated pick-up & drop-off location within the Club’s parking lot.
