Now that you are a Member...

MEMBERSHIP ID NUMBERS are issued to every member your first day attending the Club. Please remember your ID Number every time you visit the club, as you will need it to sign in at the front desk in order to record your attendance.



CLUB MEMBER ORIENTATION sessions will be offered by our Club Staff beginning in September through the rest of the school year, to review the Club rules with our members and get you comfortable with your surroundings.

SUPERVISION - The Club employs 3 full-time and 7 part-time staff members to supervise and direct programs. Every program area of the Club is staffed at all times during the hours we are open. All outdoor play is restricted to the side yard of the building during specific supervised hours.



PARENT PICKUP - Please help our children stay safe and park in an appropriate parking spot in our lot and come in to pick up your children. We know parking can be a problem at certain times with the snow, dances and busy pickup times; but the safety of the kids is worth the few extra steps. If you would prefer to call your child or the Club ahead of time to have your child ready and waiting for you, please continue to park in an appropriate parking spot and wait for your child to walk to your vehicle. No members are allowed to hang out inside by the front doors unless they are waiting for a ride.

DISCIPLINE - The Club employs the 3-Strikes You're Out rule in regards to member discipline. In all infractions of the Club Code, the staff will attempt to provide members with... Strike ONE – Warning; Strike TWO – Suspension from the program area and parental notification; Strike THREE – Suspension from the Club, parental notification, and behavioral follow up.



VALUABLES & ELECTRONICS - The Club is NOT liable for items *lost or stolen* at the Club. It is recommended that members do not bring valuables to the Club; however, if you choose to do so, you need to lock up all valuable items you bring or leave valuables at the front desk. Due to space constraints, the front office area is not able to hold coats, backpacks, etc. You **MUST** pick up your valuables prior to leaving the Club.

PHONE CALLS - Parents, feel free to call the Club if you need to speak to your child. The office phone is limited for members to use only in emergency situations as we need to keep the phone line open and available for incoming calls.

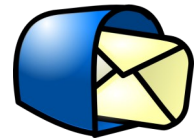
How to find out what's happening at the Club...
