CLUB MEMBER ORIENTATION sessions will be offered by our Club Staff beginning in September through the rest of the school year to review the Club rules and new guidelines with our members and get you comfortable with your surroundings and format of the Club this school year.

MEMBERSHIP ID NUMBERS are issued to every member your first day attending the Club. Please remember your ID Number every time you visit the Club as you will need it to sign in at the front desk in order to record your attendance.

PARENT DROPOFF/PICKUP INFORMATION - Please help our children stay safe and pull in and out of the parking lot *slowly*. We know parking and traffic can be a problem at certain times with the weather, events and busy times; but the safety of the kids is worth the few extra precautions and your patience. Within the pick up line, **DO NOT** pull in front of or beside another vehicle, be patient and wait for the vehicle in front of you to move up and or leave. We highly suggest you call the Club for your child's ride as you arrive and wait in your vehicle in the pick up line. If the pick up line is long, you can park in a spot and wait for your child to come out. Please then be sure to exit your vehicle and assist your child while crossing the parking lot. No members are allowed to hang out inside by the front doors unless they are waiting for their ride.



SUPERVISION - The Club employs 2 full-time & 8 part-time staff members to supervise and direct programs. Our program spaces include the Games Room, Gym, TV Room, Crafts Room, Teen Room, Mezzanine, Cooking Room, Computer Lab/Learning Center, GaGa Ball and Shelter & Outside field. Every program area of the Club is staffed at all times during the hours we are open. All outdoor play is restricted to the side yard of the building or GaGa Ball Pit during specific supervised hours.



DISCIPLINE - The Club employs the 3-Strikes You're Out rule in regards to member discipline. In all infractions of the Club Code, the staff will attempt to provide members with...

Strike ONE – Verbal Warning;

Strike TWO – Suspension from the program area and parental notification;

Strike THREE – Suspension from the Club, parental notification, and behavioral follow up.



VALUABLES & ELECTRONICS - The Club is NOT liable for any items *lost or stolen* at the Club. It is recommended that members **do not bring valuables to the Club**; you will **NOT** be able to lock up your valuable items you bring at the front desk like years past. They will be your responsibility. Due to space constraints, the front office area is not able to hold bags, toys, coats, backpacks, etc. Any items left at the end of the day will be placed in the Lost & Found bin.



PHONE CALLS - Parents, feel free to call the Club if you need to speak to your child. The office phone is limited for members to use **only in emergency situations** as we need to keep the phone line open and available for incoming calls. **This is extremely important for members to be aware of.**

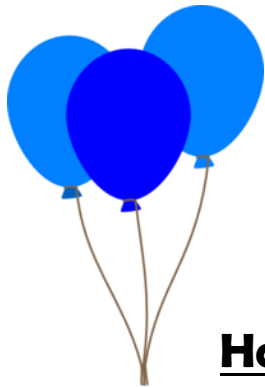

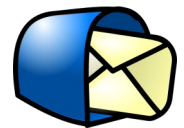
